To the Village of ckingknowledge Institute,

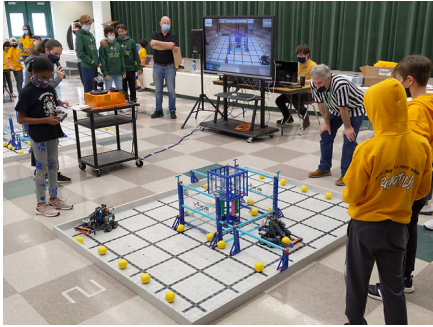
